#### Member Rules Summary

- No Felons permitted on property.
- All guests must be signed into the guest registry and are the responsibility of the authorizing member. The guest leaves with the member. In the event that the member must leave early and then return, the member may ask another member to be responsible (transfer of responsibility) for their guest temporarily until they return. If the behavior of the guest becomes an issue, the guest's member is fully responsible for that behavior, whether they are present or not. The member will have to deal with all consequences issued for the guest's poor behavior.
- The Legal spouse of a member does not have to sign the guest registry when accompanied by the member. All other family members of that member must sign the guest registry.
- The working bartender is in charge of the facility.
- No inappropriate language or behavior is allowed or tolerated. Any inappropriate activities are to be reported to the bartender. You may be asked to put it in writing.
- If there is an event in the back hall, and the member is not part of that event's guest list, the hall is off limits to that member.
- The lower outside deck is shared by all members and any guests of the event using the back hall. The upper deck is for members only. There is no smoking nor eating on the upper deck. All materials brought up to the upper deck must be removed and returned to the lower deck. No trash is to be left on the upper deck.
- In using the club's dock, all guests must be accompanied by a member. They leave the deck when the member leaves. Child under 12 are not permitted on the dock unless they are wearing a C.G.A.P.F.D.. Boats are not permitted to be tied up overnight at the dock.
- No outside alcohol of any kind allowed on property.
